

WSSUNAA Scholarship Process and Application

The Winston-Salem State University National Alumni Association is pleased to offer scholarships to persons seeking their four-year undergraduate degrees. WSSU National Alumni Association Scholarship information is available online at (www.WSSUNAA.org) and the WSSU National Alumni office.

The scholarships will be awarded to qualified individuals in the amount of **\$1,000.00 (\$500.00 per semester)** based on academic criteria and financial need over a four-year period.

Requirements

- Full time enrollment (12+ hours) at Winston-Salem State University
- Maintain a minimum 2.7 GPA
- Demonstrate a financial need (submit financial aid award letter)
- An official transcript
- Recommendations (see application)
- Essay

Current/Former Students

Applications are accepted from any student regardless of classification. Former students, who left WSSU without completing their first four year degree, may also be considered for this scholarship. However, students must meet the requirements for admission or readmission to apply for the WSSU National Alumni Scholarship.

Other Students

Individuals seeking additional undergraduate degrees, special students, unclassified, visiting or high school students, will not be considered for the WSSU National Alumni Association Scholarship.

Application Deadline

The application and supporting documents must be completed, returned and/or postmarked by **April 15th** to the address on the application or submitted electronically to WSSUNAAScholarship@gmail.com .

The WSSU National Alumni Association Scholarship Committee will review and evaluate the completed application. The Committee will provide written notification to the recipients by June 1st of the year prior to Fall Semester enrollment.

Withdrawal/Reimbursements

If a student receiving a WSSU National Alumni Association Scholarship withdraws from the university voluntarily or involuntarily, they will be required to reimburse the WSSU National Alumni Association on a prorated basis. Students are eligible to reapply for this scholarship upon being readmitted to the university.

Scholarship recipients must maintain the required grade point average of 2.7 mandated by the WSSU National Alumni Association, in order to remain eligible for the scholarship. Summer School grades will be accepted to meet the required grade point average. The WSSU National Alumni Scholarship chairperson will verify enrollment status for continued eligibility. Each scholarship recipient is required to volunteer ten (10) hours each semester with the National Alumni Association. Students who are awarded the scholarship for the first time are requested to meet the Association's Board at its first meeting of the academic year, which is held in the fall of each year. Date, place and time of this meeting will be forwarded to each recipient.
