2022 OFFICER / REGIONAL COORDINATOR ELECTIONS

- January 15 Association members sent request of candidates for elective office by January 15 of the election year.
- February 15 Receive nominations for elective positions postmarked by February 15 of the election year.
- March 1 Candidate profiles and voting instructions sent to financial Association members on record as of February 28 and notify regional coordinators and chapter presidents of the distribution by March 1 of the election year.
- April 1 All ballots, when mailed, must be postmarked by April 1 of the election year. Electronic or onsite balloting procedures must be developed by the nominating committee.
- April 15 The Nominating Committee shall count ballots, notify candidates of results by April 15 of the election year.
- Regional Coordinators shall be elected by members and/or chapters of the designated region during the same year elections are held for the officers of the Association. Regional Coordinators must be financial and in good standing with the Association.
